

The Kansas Organ, Eye and Tissue Donor Registry is a confidential list of organ, eye and tissue donors maintained by Midwest Transplant Network. You are not required to be on the registry to be a donor and can remove your name at any time. You may also amend or revoke your decision at any time. Placing your name on the registry means you authorize to have your organs and tissues given to others upon your death. Enrollment in the registry makes your decision final unless revoked in a manner provided by law. To be removed from the Kansas Registry, please complete the Kansas Registry Removal/Revocation Form and submit as instructed. To amend your Kansas Registry information, please complete the Kansas Registry Amendment Form and submit as instructed.

## Amend Authorization:

You may amend your registry record by going to DonateLifeKansas.com and logging in to your account. Once logged in, select "Update Your Donation Wishes," or complete and print a Kansas Registry Amendment Form available at <u>DonateLifeKansas.com/KSRegistryAmendmentForm.pdf</u>. You can also request a paper form by calling (888) 744-4531. If completing a paper form, please submit as instructed.

## **Revocation:**

You may withdraw or revoke your authorization to be listed on the registry. This action does not mean a refusal to make an anatomical gift. Upon your death, other authorized persons may make such a gift for you. To revoke your authorization, you must complete the Kansas Registry Removal/Revocation Form available at <u>DonateLifeKansas.com/KSRegistryRemovalForm.pdf</u>. You can also request a paper form by calling (888) 744-4531. If completing a paper form, please submit as instructed.

## Refusal:

If you refuse to make an anatomical gift and want to bar others from doing so on your behalf, you may execute a refusal by completing one of the steps below. Be sure to provide copies of your documentation to family, friends or others who may be making end-of-life decisions for you. This information will not be included in the registry or maintained by Midwest Transplant Network.

- A record or writing signed by you
- A will
- A record or writing signed by another person at your direction, if you are physically unable to sign, and witnessed by at least two adults, one being a disinterested witness, who sign at your request and attest to such act
- A communication made by you in any form during your terminal illness or injury, addressed to at least two adults, one of whom is a disinterested witness
